

Young Artist Piano Trio Application Guidelines

Now in its third year, **Rocky Ridge Young Artist Piano Trio**, made possible by the Eric John Bundy Memorial Fund, is a fellowship program of the Young Artist Seminar (YAS) from June 18 to July 14 at Rocky Ridge Music Center in Estes Park, Colorado. Exceptional violinists, cellists, and pianists between the ages 18 to 24 at the start of YAS are eligible to apply. Trio fellows receive full tuition support, housing, and meals. Upon completing the Young Artist Seminar, the Trio will function as ambassadors for one year at venues recommended by Rocky Ridge with the goal of advancing music education and increasing appreciation of chamber music in communities around the nation. Portion of the proceeds from a summer benefit concert featuring the Trio will be directed towards travel support for their ambassadorial work.

- Check the box “Yes, I want to be considered for the Young Artist Piano Trio Fellowship”
- Upload one solo and one chamber music performance samples
- Submit a chamber music repertoire list
- Provide emails of three recommenders
- Pay the non-refundable \$85 application fee
- Apply by March 15, 2019
